All Parents and spectators are expected to:

- i. Do their best to demonstrate "Good Sportsmanship" at all times. They will not condone, permit, defend or engage in actions, on or off the ice, which are not consistent with good sportsmanship;
- ii. Encourage their child to do his or her best, have fun and demonstrate good sportsmanship, how to win and lose gracefully and will lead by example;
- iii. Help their child to understand and respect the rules of the game;

- v. Respect the rights and feelings of officials, coaches, trainers, players, volunteers and administrators;

- vii. Use Social media in a respectful manner, and remember that any Identifiers of the IMHA remain the property of the IMHA and are subject to removal

All Parents are reminded that failure to adhere to the IMHA Parental Code of Conduct will result in one of the following:

- i. The IMHA will limit Parental access to the team and or facilities
- ii. The IMHA will suspend the Parent, baring said Parent from contact with the team and from attending any Team function including games or practices.
- iii. Failure of the parent to follow the suspension will result in their child being suspended.
